But it was in the early '90s when Duarte's dark, rebellious aesthetic collided with the rock world. Lenny Kravitz, preparing to open for David Bowie, personally sought Duarte out to sharpen his iconic stage look. That introduction led directly to Axl Rose of Guns N' Roses, and the rest was history.

Operating from his storefront on Sunset Boulevard in West Hollywood, Duarte spent the next two decades creating **signature leather trenches**, **lace-up jeans**, **and full performance wardrobes** for Alice in Chains, The Cure, Smashing Pumpkins, Nirvana, and others. His style didn't just appear on stage — it influenced millions of fans who mirrored the looks of their musical heroes.

For over 25 years, Duarte was the *designer of the rock world* — and this trench, made exclusively for Kotzen, is a living artifact of that legacy.
